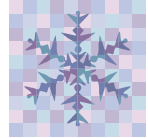

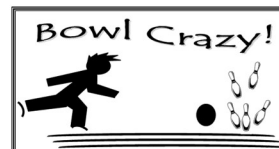

- ◆ **Parents/Guardians:** AT SENCC we value your child and enjoy having them at our community center. We place a high priority on their safety, both on the way to the center and while at the center. In view of those facts we are asking all parents to help us reinforce the need for their student to follow directions given by the adult staff and volunteers and the junior volunteers. Examples would be continued talking when the whistle is blown, running in a “walking zone,” or going into an “off limits” area of the building. That creates an unsafe environment at the center. This month we are talking to the students about these and other issues that are important in life: respect, honesty, treating others the way you would also want to be treated, safety issues, etc. We do need your help at home reinforcing the need for them to listen to directions given while coming to the center and while here...we care about them and want them to be safe here. Because of the high importance of these issues we feel that any student who chooses not to listen and follow directions will be given a day or days off from the center. Thank you for your cooperation!
- ◆ **Note to parents:** just a reminder to use parking on the community center side of the alley. We want to be good neighbors to those whose only parking is on the east side of the alley. Please avoid double parking in the alley—we want to maintain a level of safety for students in that loading zone.
- ◆ Please check our lost and found area for any coats, backpacks, etc that your child may have left at the community center.
- ◆ Students should not bring personal items (toys, games, jewelry, electronics ie: ipod/mp3's, hand-held video games, make-up, perfumed items, Legos and Pokemon/Yugio and those types of cards etc.) from home. The community center does not take responsibility for students' personal items being lost or stolen.
- ◆ Heelies, shoes containing roller skating wheels in the sole, may only be worn at the community center if the wheels are removable and have been popped out before, during and after school. The Heelies cause damage to floors and are a danger to children. Rollerblades, skates, skateboards and scooters are also not allowed on the gym floor.
- ◆ Students are not permitted to use the community center telephone except for emergencies. Students are not allowed to use their cell phones at the center except to communicate with parents/guardians.

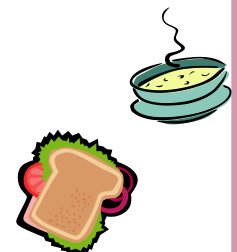
